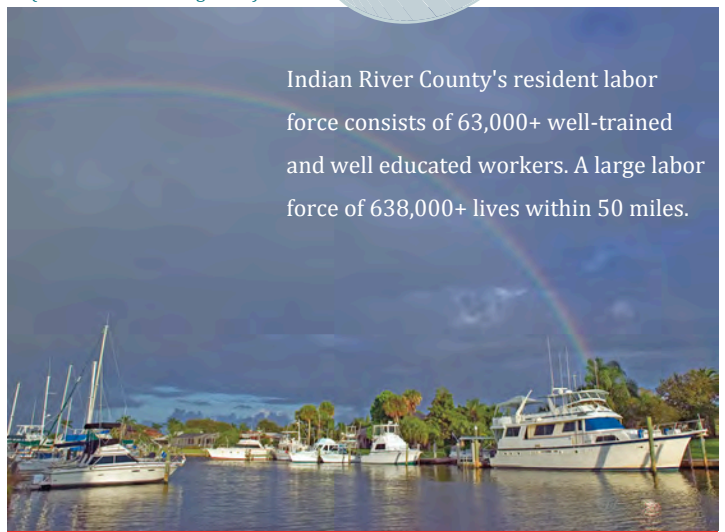

An excellent transportation network that includes highways, railroads, airports, and seaports provides easy access to state, national, and international markets. The closest port, Port Canaveral, is designated as a Foreign Trade Zone and can easily ship products throughout the world.

Airports



Melbourne International Airport

- 40 miles north of Vero Beach
- Airlines include Delta, American Airlines, Porter, and Elite Airways
- Direct flights to Charlotte, Atlanta and the Bahamas, with connections worldwide

Vero Beach Regional Airport

- Public-use general aviation airport
- Elite Airways offers scheduled nonstop service between Vero Beach and NYC/Newark
- 3 runways, the longest at 7,314 ft
- Home to Piper Aircraft and Flight Safety Academy

Sebastian Municipal Airport

- Uses 2 runways to serve small personal and corporate aircraft
- Home to LoPresti Aviation and Skydive Sebastian

Orlando International Airport

- Serves over 38 airlines
- Non-stop service to 76 U.S. destinations, including; New York, Las Vegas, Charlotte, Chicago, Denver, Seattle, Los Angeles, Dallas
- Non-stop service to 54 International destinations



Utilities in Indian River County are high quality, readily available, and reliable, maximizing businesses' uptime and giving them a competitive advantage.

Electricity - Provided by Florida Power and Light. Typical business customer bills are lower than the state, regional and national averages (source: Edison Electric Institute Typical Bills and Average Rates Reports for Winter 2013). FPL offers special economic development rates for large power users and growing companies that are creating new jobs. Electricity in the City of Vero Beach is provided by the municipality.

Natural Gas - Florida City Gas provides natural gas service to the region.

Water/Wastewater - Services are provided either by Indian River County Utilities or by the municipalities of Vero Beach, Fellsmere, or Sebastian, depending on the location.

Telecommunications - Providers serving the region include AT&T, TruMobility Inc., Nextiva, Comcast, Verizon, T-Mobile, Sprint
